How to Register for Sports:

STEP ONE: Complete the **BLUE PERMIT CARD**. Bring to the annual doctor's physical exam to get doctor's signature, stamp and date of physical. Be sure to sign EVERY waiver and consent agreement on the card (parent and student).

STEP TWO: **HAND DELIVER** the blue permit card to the Athletic Office during the **APPROPRIATE REGISTRATION DATES** (see below)

Registrations Dates:

FALL

June 1st – August 1st Fall Sports begin Wed, August 13

(summer office hours are 8am-3:30pm, Monday-Thursday; 8am-Noon on Friday; office is closed July 3rd)

WINTER

Oct. 20th – Nov. 3rd Girls Basketball begins Nov. 3

Oct. 27th – Nov. 10th Boys Basketball, Girls Gymnastics, Wrestling begin Nov. 10

Nov. 10th – Nov. 24th Boys Swimming & Diving begins Nov. 24

Jan. 5th – Jan. 19th Boys Indoor Track and Girls Indoor Track begin Jan. 19

SPRING

Feb. 2nd – Feb. 16th Boys Gymnastics begins Feb. 16

Feb. 16th – Mar. 2nd Girls Soccer, Baseball, Badminton, Girls Water Polo, Boys Water Polo, Girls Lacrosse, Boys Lacrosse, Boys Tennis, Softball begin March 2

Feb. 22nd – Mar 9th Boys Volleyball begins March 9

STEP THREE: The Athletic Office will issue a **PINK SLIP** upon receipt of the blue permit card once academic eligibility has been cleared. THIS PINK SLIP MUST BE GIVEN TO THE COACH ON THE FIRST DAY OF TRYOUTS/PRACTICE. Students without pink slips can NOT participate.

PLEASE NOTE:

- In order to try out, every student must have a recent physical exam that clears the athlete for participation. The exams are good for one year and must not expire during an athlete's season or the student can't register.
- The athletic permit form is good for the ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR. If you tried out for a fall sport you do not have to resubmit another permit card to participate in a winter or spring sport, unless your physical will expire during your sports season.

Physical Exams for ETHS Athletes

Students have another option for sports physicals besides seeing their regular physician. **The ETHS Health Center, located in Evanston Township High School, offers sport physicals and immunizations to all students (Spanish-speaking staff available).**

Summer Dates for Sports Physicals at the ETHS Health Center:

- **If attending** summer school, **please schedule your appointment ASAP.**
- **Sports Physicals are available for ALL students June 18-July 31.**
- **ONLY Incoming freshmen can schedule physicals during the month of August (sports physicals = school physicals).**

Academic Requirements

Required Eligibility Grade Point Average (GPA)

In order to participate in an extra-curricular activity, a student must have earned a minimum **2.0 GPA** (calculated using the criteria below) from the **previous semester**.

- Summer school grades are included in second semester grades
- Physical education grades are included in the GPA
- **An NC or Incomplete is computed as an 'F'**

Weekly Grade Checks & Academic Probation

Weekly grade checks are done for all student-athletes while they are participating in their activity to determine their eligibility. Student-athletes must be passing a minimum of four classes in order to participate the next week beginning on Monday. Student-athletes who have at least two classes with a grade of C- or worse, are still eligible to participate, but are placed on Academic Probation and must attend three academic tutorials the next week in order to maintain their eligibility to participate in their activity.

EAP one-time opportunity

Students who do not meet the 2.0 GPA requirement may be eligible for the Extra-curricular Academic Plan (EAP). The EAP provides the participant with academic support for the **entire semester**, allowing the participant to participate in extra-curricular activities for that semester. In order to qualify for this **one-time opportunity**, a student must either be:

- A freshman/sophomore who earned between a 1.70-1.99 GPA the previous semester
- A junior/senior who earned between a 1.70-1.99 GPA the previous semester **and** has a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above

EAP participants are placed on academic probation and must attend the EAP study hall every Monday morning from 8:00-8:35am for the **entire semester**. EAP participants who do not meet these expectations will be suspended from the activity for the remainder of the semester. **Students may access this EAP opportunity only *once* during their high school career.**

Practice Eligibility Program (P.E.P.)

A student who does not meet the ETHS academic eligibility requirements for extra-curricular activities, but meets the IHSA requirements, may still have an opportunity to participate in an extra-curricular activity if the following provisions are met:

- The student passed four or more classes the previous semester. NC's and Incompletes are considered as failing grades.
- The coach/director/sponsor selects the student to be part of their activity.
- The student does **not compete/perform** during the semester in which they are ineligible. The student may sit/stand with the team during the event, but is not allowed to dress in the game uniform.
- The student participates in the EAP which requires mandatory attendance at the EAP study hall every Monday morning from 8:00-8:35am for the **entire semester**.
