The Naperville North High School Athletic Hall of Fame is being established to recognize the outstanding athletic team and individual achievement at North High School. Naperville North had it's first graduating class in 1976. Since that time it has had numerous individual and team state champions. Naperville North has become recognized as one of the most successful athletic programs in the state. For these reasons alone we felt it was justified to start an Athletic Hall of Fame.

This Hall of Fame is designed to have community involvement in the nomination process. It is your job as the fan to make the committee aware of those athletes whom you feel are the best of the best and have been excellent representatives of our athletic programs and community over the years.

Here are the following catagories:

- 1) **State Champions** - Individual and team State Champions from any sport. Candidates shall become eligible for induction seven (7) years after graduation.
- 2) **All State** - Individuals or teams who have been selected to any recognized All State Team. Candidates shall become eligible for induction seven (7) years after graduation.
- 3) **Outstanding Athletic Contributors** - Those athletes who do not fall in any of the other criteria, however their contributions in multiple sports while at Naperville North High School helped set the foundation and tradition we become accustomed to at Naperville North.
- 4) **Post High School Achievement** - All men and women who earned varsity athletic monograms during high school and, after high school, brought honor to Naperville North High School by their outstanding civic achievements or post high school athletic careers.
- 5) **Outstanding Contributors** - All men and women who have made outstanding contributions to the athletic programs at Naperville North High School.

ARTICLE VIII...INDUCTION

Hall of Fame members shall be inducted in January/ February following their election. Induction shall be limited to five (5) entries per year. Twenty inductees (20) for the inaugural class only, Ten inductees (10) for the second year, five (5) every year after that. **Beginning with the Class of 2008, the Board shall select up to five athletes and may select one team and/or coach to the Hall of Fame.**

The number of inductees installed in the inaugural Hall of Fame induction shall be determined by the Board of Directors. but divided evenly as possible between the pre 1991 era and post 1991 era.
