

Proviso Township High Schools District 209
Athletic/Activities Eligibility Procedures
District Policy 6:190

The following procedures shall be used in implementing District 209 policy regarding academic criteria for participation in extracurricular and co-curricular athletics and activities:

- Students participating in extracurricular and co-curricular athletics and activities must satisfy the Illinois High School Association's scholastic standing requirements.
 - In order to participate, students must have passed at least four classes in the previous semester. 1st Semester Freshmen students are exempt from this requirement.
 - Students must be passing at least four classes during each weekly eligibility check.
- If a student is eligible per IHSA guidelines, but had a semester GPA of less than 2.000 for the previous semester, the student will be placed on remediation.
 - Students on remediation must report to a mandatory tutoring session at least twice during the week in the subject area(s) for which they had received a grade of less than "C" in the previous semester.
 - Students on remediation can continue to participate in their club or sport, but must turn in a signed sheet to the Athletic or Activities Director stating that they attended the required tutoring sessions.
 - The Athletic/Activities Director will monitor students on remediation, and will inform Head Coaches/Sponsors of student weekly eligibility and remediation compliance. Students who fail to attend the required tutoring, or who fail to meet IHSA guidelines for weekly eligibility will be declared ineligible.
 - Students on remediation who receive a 1st or 3rd quarter grade of "B" or better in a subject area for which they have been receiving tutoring will not be required to continue tutoring in that subject area.
- Any student who begins a semester eligible, regardless of his/her GPA from the previous semester, will be required to attend mandatory tutoring in any subject area for which he/she receives a 1st or 3rd quarter grade of "D" or lower. Such students will be placed on remediation until the end of the semester in any course for which they receive a 1st or 3rd quarter grade of "D" or lower.
- The MVP awards given to a senior athlete/participant will be presented only to those outstanding participants who have a cumulative GPA of 2.000 or higher.
