

# NCAA ONLINE REGISTRATION

As a prospective college-bound student-athlete, you are required to register with the NCAA Clearinghouse if you plan on playing sports at the collegiate level in Division I or II. The Clearinghouse will determine your eligibility to participate.

The NCAA Clearinghouse is encouraging all student-athletes to register on-line by the middle of their **junior year**. To register, please follow the directions below:

1. Go to the internet and log on to <http://eligibilitycenter.org>
2. Click on "Fall 2010 or after"
3. Click on "New Account" in the upper right hand corner or click on the telephone on left side and follow directions
4. You will be emailed information with a PIN after you have created your account
5. Go back onto the website and login in with your new account information
6. The WEST AURORA HIGH SCHOOL code is 140185
7. Sign up on the red clipboard in the guidance office to request that a copy of your transcript is sent to the NCAA Clearinghouse. The registrar (301-5566) will mail it for you.
8. Bring Mrs. Winslow this form with your Clearinghouse ID # to keep on file (make a copy of this form for yourself)
9. Send your official transcripts to the NCAA Clearinghouse at the end of junior year. (If you attended a high school prior to WAHS it is your responsibility to have your transcripts sent from that school to the Clearinghouse separately)
10. After graduation, request that the registrar send a final transcript into the Clearinghouse
11. **IF YOU TOOK OR PLAN ON TAKING SUMMER SCHOOL, SEE MRS. WINSLOW ASAP**

## IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN AND STUDENT TO:

1. Apply to the NCAA Clearinghouse online (our NEXUS CENTER has computers available for use or the Aurora Library if you do not access at home) by the middle of your junior year
2. Request that our registrar send your transcripts to update your file with the Clearinghouse at the end of junior year and after graduation
3. Keep up Grade Point Average with grades of C, B, and A in CORE classes (D and F grades in CORE classes jeopardize your chances of meeting the QUALIFYING standards and your chances of obtaining scholarship opportunities)
4. Monitor current status and deficiencies through pulling up the online evaluation so that you can make changes in your curriculum if you need to with your counselor
5. **MAKE SURE YOU ARE TAKING COLLEGE BOUND CURRICULUM AT WAHS:** 4 years English, 3 years Algebra 1 or higher, 3 years Lab Science, 3 years Social Studies, 3 years additional core classes from any of the above listed areas or Foreign Language to equal **16 core credits for D-I and 14 core classes for D-II.**
